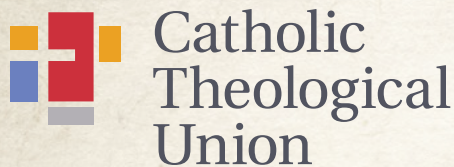


A Retreat in the Holy Land

Trip applications must be completed online by February 28, 2020. \$400 non-refundable deposit is due with application. Space is limited. Early application submissions are encouraged.

Retreat cost is \$4,250 per person and includes roundtrip airfare from Chicago, double-occupancy accommodations, entrance fees, gratuities, retreat presentations, ground transportation, and breakfast and supper each day. Participants are responsible for all other expenses incurred, and must be in good health and able to walk unassisted on uneven ground for at least one mile, as the retreat requires daily hikes. Single-room: additional \$895. Land portion only: \$2,850.
