#### Dear CTU Student Community,

I pray that each of you is well and is finding some time to rest and reflect after the academic year has come to a close. I want you to know how important you are to this community as a scholar. Each of you brings a unique and important presence to this community that is intellectual, emotional and spiritual. Thank you for that. The faculty, staff and administration of CTU understand that it is a privilege to have you as a part of our mission and indeed contributing to our mission. You bring life and spirit along with intellectual curiosity and scholarship to this school.

I wanted to take a moment and bring you up to speed. I have been trying to keep you in the loop as CTU looks to the Fall 2020 Term. There have been six task forces at work looking at every optic and aspect of CTU to provide the best advice possible to our President about decisions that affect the health and welfare of our CTU community as we move toward the next academic year. Our goal has been to develop a way forward that provides the highest quality of theological learning in an environment that respects social distancing and hygienic protocols.

I am happy to inform you that our President has accepted the unanimous advice of Task Force 2020 to open our Fall Term 2020 as scheduled in our school calendar and as posted on our website. We expect our campus to be clean and ready for classes as scheduled for the Fall Term. At the same time there will be some differences as we pivot to respond to COVID. All courses scheduled as Face to Face classes at CTU will be taught as hybrid courses. In other words, for the twelve scheduled class meetings, the class will alternate weekly between Face to Face and online, so that six will be on campus and six will be online. Hybrid classes will move on a regular weekly schedule between on campus and online. This will enable us to keep the number of students on campus lower by half each day, allowing us to clean every classroom between classes, use only our larger classrooms so only one student sits at each table, and allows for great social distancing during breaks, etc.

All courses already scheduled to be online will continue to be online.

As Dean, I really want to assure you that you can rely on our exceptional faculty to provide the same high quality of theological education that is both bold and faithful that you have come to expect here at CTU.

I have attached a list of classroom social distancing and hygiene protocols. Also I have attached a list of our Fall Term 2020 course offerings that marks courses with either their "A" or "B" designation, so you can plan your on-campus class days.

### Fall 2020 Hybrid Protocols

CTU Fall 2020 semester face-to-face (F2F) classes be taught as hybrid classes. These classes will be taught face to face one week and online the alternating week. Each course has been assigned a week designation, Week A or Week B. For the online weeks; a professor may choose either synchronous or asynchronous distance education. However, synchronous online teaching will take place on the same day and time as in the official course offerings. See Weekly Hybrid schedule and the updated Fall 2020 course schedule for full details of course meeting dates.

All classes scheduled to be taught online will stay completely online.

#### Student Classroom Protocols for the Fall

- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, in the fall, both students and faculty will enter a CTU or classroom environment that is "different" in some ways than they have known in the past. The fact that these protocols are being established is evidence of changes that will require the cooperation and patience of everyone.
- Practice social distancing and proper hygiene.
- Practice proper spacing in classrooms by keeping one person to a table. If there are multiple students in the class who live together in the same religious house they should sit together in the same general area of the classroom.
- All persons present at CTU will follow CTU general guidelines regarding the wearing of masks in the classrooms and building
- Eating in the classroom is not permitted. Drinking liquids is allowed as long as the cup/container has a cover.
- If you wish for a one-to-one meeting with the professor, explore the possibilities of a videoconference meeting or meeting in a space that allows for proper distancing.
- During class breaks, be mindful to practice social distancing. Anyone who congregates in a way that compromises social distancing will be politely reminded to keep their distance from one another.
- Technical support for online learning is offered at CTU from the Help Desk and the Office of the Director of Educational Technology.
- Students unfamiliar with online learning should email the professor with questions.
