	their lecture material in an interactive format and students are required to
	engage each other in some form of discussion (i.e. chats or forums) and to
	complete assignments.
On Campus	Face-to-Face
	Courses where the lessons are presented in a physical/concrete classroom
Zoom	and via Zoom where the professors and students are together at a set day
	and time. Students will have the option to enroll in the on-campus
	classroom section or the Zoom-only section.
Hybrid On Campus	Hybrid On Campus
	The course is offered in a mixed modality. From week to week some
Hybrid Zoom	sessions are in a campus classroom and Zoom at same time, others are on
	Zoom synchronous or completely online asynchronous. Students will have
	the option to enroll in the classroom section or the Zoom-only section.
Zoom	Zoom only Course
	Students attend online synchronously via a video-conferencing platform
