



Volunteers Wanted for China Conference in Chicago

The U.S. China Catholic Association (USCCA) a 501c3 nonprofit is looking for volunteer rapporteurs and conference staff interested in learning about the Church in China. The USCCA is sponsoring an international conference this summer at DePaul University on Friday August 2, 2024 through August 4, 2024. We are looking for ten (10) volunteers. There are three functions needed.

1. The rapporteurs would act as in-house reporters and bloggers, documenting the keynote presentations, the panels and the question-and-answer sessions. The rapporteurs would be credited in the conference program and in a published pamphlet/book memorializing the conference. All proceedings will be in English.
2. The conference staff would be responsible for offering radical hospitality to conference attendees, including Chinese bishops, theologians, religious women and academics many of them traveling from across China, Taiwan, and Europe by facilitating their attendance at the conference. All attendees will communicate in English.
3. A videographer team who can manage and direct the video recording of the presentations and panels is also needed. Expertise in video recording and providing personal video equipment will be properly compensated.

All volunteers will have the opportunity to attend the conference proceedings Friday evening, all day Saturday including the authentic Chinese banquet in Chinatown, and Sunday. The conference ends at noon on Sunday. All meals during the conference will also be provided.

Compensation: A stipend of \$250 for the weekend will be provided to each volunteer.
