



Course Delivery Method Definitions

Delivery Method(s) Used on Course Schedule	Description
Asynchronous	<p><i>Asynchronous</i></p> <p>Students participate asynchronously on an online platform (i.e. D2L). There are no set days or times or required live sessions in this mode. However, there are required time periods in which professors are required to deliver their lecture material in an interactive format and students are required to engage each other in some form of discussion (i.e. chats or forums) and to complete assignments.</p>
On Campus Zoom	<p><i>Face-to-Face</i></p> <p>Courses where the lessons are presented in a physical/ concrete classroom and via Zoom where the professors and students are together at a set day and time. Students will have the option to enroll in the on-campus classroom section or the Zoom-only section.</p>
Hybrid On Campus Hybrid Zoom	<p><i>Hybrid On Campus</i></p> <p>The course is offered in a mixed modality. From week to week some sessions are in a campus classroom and Zoom at same time, others are on Zoom synchronous or completely online asynchronous. Students will have the option to enroll in the classroom section or the Zoom-only section.</p>
Zoom	<p><i>Zoom only Course</i></p> <p>Students attend online synchronously via a video-conferencing platform (i.e. Zoom) with the professor at a set day and time.</p>
